Daniel 1:8 But Daniel resolved not to defile himself with the royal food and wine, and he asked the chief official for permission not to defile himself this way.

2 Chronicles 36 Vs 2-3

Jehoahaz was twenty-three years old when he became king, and he reigned in Jerusalem three months. The king of Egypt dethroned him in Jerusalem and imposed on Judah a levy of a hundred talents of silver and a talent of gold.

Vs 5 Jehoiakim ...He did evil in the eyes of the LORD his God.

Vs 9 Jehoiachin ...He did evil in the eyes of the LORD.

Daniel was 16 or 17 years old

The world in which Daniel was born and lived was falling apart Daniel lived in a 2 Peter 2 world and had a 2 Peter 1 faith

Deuteronomy 6 Vs 1-2

These are the commands, decrees and laws the LORD your God directed me to teach you to observe in the land that you are crossing the Jordan to possess, so that you, your children and their children after them may fear the LORD your God as long as you live by keeping all His decrees and commands that I give you, and so that you may enjoy long life.

Vs 3-4

Hear, O Israel, and be careful to obey so that it may go well with you and that you may increase greatly in a land flowing with milk and honey, just as the LORD, the God of your fathers, promised you. Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one.

Vs 5-6

Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. These commandments that I give you today are to be upon your hearts.
