

In 1975 there were about 9000 different items in the average grocery store

Today the average grocery store has nearly 40,000

To read the label of every item would take about19 days

Average person makes 2.2 trips to the store per week

The most common purchases are milk, coffee, soda, bread, and eggs

20% of purchases are impulse buys

When Jesus had entered Capernaum, a centurion came to Him, asking for help. "Lord," he said, "my servant lies at home paralyzed and in terrible suffering." Vs 7-8

Jesus said to him, "I will go and heal him." The centurion replied, "Lord, I do not deserve to have you come under my roof. But just say the word, and my servant will be healed.

Then Jesus said to the centurion, "Go! It will be done just as you believed it would." And his servant was healed at that very hour. 
