Patience: the ability to endure aggravation, adversity, trouble, or suffering without becoming annoyed or upset

Being patience was being mistaken with being a pushover

Pushover: somebody who is easily persuaded, deceived, or defeated

soft, easy prey, a sucker, "yellow"

Just because there is not a display of power does not mean there is no power

Do not mistake being patience for being a pushover

Luke 21:27

At that time they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory.

Revelation 19 Vs 11-12

I saw heaven standing open and there before me was a white horse, whose rider is called Faithful and True. With justice He judges and makes war. His eyes are like blazing fire, and on His head are many crowns. He has a name written on Him that no one knows but He himself.

Vs 13-14

He is dressed in a robe dipped in blood, and His name is the Word of God. The armies of heaven were following Him, riding on white horses and dressed in fine linen, white and clean.

Vs 15

Out of His mouth comes a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations. "He will rule them with an iron scepter." He treads the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God Almighty.

Our God is patient but He is not a pushover

Romans 2:4

...do you show contempt for the riches of His kindness, tolerance and patience, not realizing that God's kindness leads you toward repentance?

"Wilt thou render of none effect that marked benevolence of God toward thee which has given so many superior advantages, and that forbearance which has tolerated thy many miscarriages, and that long-suffering which, after repeated provocations, still continues to bear with thee"

Adam Clarke, a British theologian and biblical scholar who lived from 1760-1832

Wilt thou continue to think God is a pushover

Or

Wilt thou grasp all that His kindness, tolerance, and patience provides

What does living in God's patience produce?

Psalm 23 Vs 1a The LORD is my shepherd

Without God's patience we would be lost, wandering and without hope

Vs 1b I shall not be in want.

Without God's patience our "want container" would be filled by garbage rather than grace

Vs 2-3a

He makes me lie down in green pastures, He leads me beside quiet waters, He restores my soul.

Without God's patience there would be no provision in the here and now

Vs 3b

He guides me in paths of righteousness for His name's sake.

Without God's patience there would be no right path to walk on

Vs4

Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.

Without God's patience we are in the valley alone

You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies.

Without God's patience the table would be empty

You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows.

Without God's patience there is no purpose to life

Vs 6

Surely goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever.

Without God's patience there is not dwelling in THE House
