The "In" part of the Very Presence of God

Vs 5

Vs 6Then one of the seraphs flew to me with a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with tongs from the altar.

Vs 7

With it he touched my mouth and said, "See, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away and your sin atoned for."

The forgiving process can be painful
