



The Dash Between the Years

Is that living life in the highest manner?

The word of Christ dwelling richly in us produces the good life

How do I let the Word of Christ dwell in me richly?

Ephesians 5 Vs 18 Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit.

Vs 19-20

Speak to one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord, always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Ephesians 5:18-20 + Colossians 3:16-17 Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit. Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom, and as you sing psalms, hymns and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God. Speak to one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. There is this agreement between the Word of Christ and the Spirit that produces the same results John 16:12 I have much more to say to you, more than you can now bear.

Vs 13

But when the Spirit, the Spirit of truth, comes, the Spirit of truth will guide you into all truth. The Spirit of truth will not speak on His own; the Spirit of truth will speak only what He hears, and the Spirit of truth will tell you what is yet to come.

Vs 14-15

The Spirit of truth will bring glory to me by taking from what is mine and making it known to you. All that belongs to the Father is mine. That is why I said the Spirit will take from what is mine and make it known to you. The Spirit of truth is going to take what is Jesus' and make it known to us?

Does the Spirit of truth speak the Word of truth to you and me?

Is that the language the Spirit Uses?

Does the Spirit of truth use the Word of Truth that we know as He talks to us and guides our lives? So if the word of Christ is to dwell in me richly I need the Spirit of Truth and the Word of Truth in the same environment The Word of Truth is what is planted and the Spirit of truth is the one who plants it

If I am not

being filled with the Spirit of truth
consuming the Word of Truth
letting it dwell richly in me

The Good Life will only be an undefined concept and not a reality

Because without the Word of Christ dwelling in us richly we are bound to our opinions, limited by our experience, and tainted by our depravity

So how can I let the Word of Christ dwell in me richly?

Ephesians 1:13 And you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation. Having believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit...

Believe and receive the Holy Spirit

John 6:67-68 "You do not want to leave too, do you?" Jesus asked the Twelve. Simon Peter answered him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life.

#2

Believe that the Word is the giver of life

Matthew 4:4

Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God."

#3

Believe that the Word is a daily need

Jeremiah 15:16 When your words came, I ate them; they were my joy and my heart's delight, for I bear your name, O LORD God Almighty.

Believe that the Word is producing joy and pleasure at the deepest level

John 17:17 Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth.

Believe that the Word is making me holy

Psalm 119:105 Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path.
