2 Peter 1

Vs 13-14

I think it is right to refresh your memory as long as I live in the tent of this body, because I know that I will soon put it aside, as our Lord Jesus Christ has made clear to me.

Vs 15

And I will make every effort to see that
after my departure you will always be
able to remember these things.

Vs 16

We did not follow cleverly invented stories when we told you about the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we were eyewitnesses of His majesty.

Vs 17

For He received honor and glory from God the Father when the voice came to Him from the Majestic Glory, saying, "This is my Son, whom I love; with Him I am well pleased."

Vs 18

We ourselves heard this voice that came
from heaven when we were with Him
on the sacred mountain.

Vs 19

And we have the word of the prophets
made more certain, and you will do
well to pay attention to it, as to a light
shining in a dark place, until the day
dawns and the morning star rises in
your hearts.

Vs 20-21

Above all, you must understand that no prophecy of Scripture came about by the prophet's own interpretation. For prophecy never had its origin in the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.

Two major measuring sticks of our
“yes” are our giving and our going

Giving

Average household income for our area is \$56,951 or \$27/hr

The average Christian gives 2% of their income to Christian causes

\$56,951 – the giving is \$1139.02/year

This is \$21.90/week

Of that \$21.90
7% is utilized to reach to the ends of
the earth

This is \$1.53/week

Of that \$1.53

2% goes to reach the people who have
no witness of Jesus in their “world”

This is \$.03/week

Going to our “world”

8% of Christians believe that sharing their faith is “very important”

50% of practicing Christians believe that non Christians have no interest in hearing about Jesus

Almost 70% of Christians believe that
everyone ends up in heaven

93% of practicing Christians are not
comfortable with having a conversation
about Jesus with their own
grandchildren

Going to the ends of the earth

World's population 7.67 Billion people

400,000 workers across the world

1 worker for every 19,175 people

Worker

Ephesians 4:11-12

It was He who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up...

41.6% of the 7.67 Billion people have
no known Gospel of Jesus witness

That is 3.19 Billion people that have no
one to tell them about Jesus

400,000 workers across the world

3% of those workers go to the 3.19 Billion
without a Jesus witness

12,000 workers to reach 3.19 billion people

With \$.03/ week from all the other
Christians

The Church has roughly 3,000 times
the financial resources and 9,000 times
the manpower needed to finish the
Great Commission.

If every Christian gave 10% of their
income to missions we could easily
support 2 million new missionaries.

Haggai 1

Vs 2-3

This is what the LORD Almighty says:

"These people say, 'The time has not yet come for the LORD's house to be built.'" Then the word of the LORD came through the prophet Haggai:

Vs 4-5

Pray 2 minutes a day
